

## **Schedule Design Overview**

We are ALL IN! We are committed to a full, 5-day, robust schedule. This weekly overview will be in place **from September through June**, regardless of whether we are on campus or online with consistency for you at home and for teachers as they plan to deliver live, vibrant instruction and enrichment daily.

## **Helpful Terms**

**Synchronous:** all students doing the same thing with a teacher at the same time, regardless of the location – whether learning on campus or online

**Asynchronous**: students learning at varied times, varied places, completing assignments independently on their schedule

**Virtual**: student learning via technology, a combination of both synchronous and asynchronous

**De-densify**: reducing the number of students on campus and in a particular space to accommodate for our "Safer at 6" physical distancing protocols

**Cohort**: a smaller group of students resulting from the need to de-densify the campus; these cohorts will remain consistent throughout the day and have limited mixing with other groups
